Requirements

- A grade of "C" or better in each course is required for successful satisfaction of core and elective courses.
- All students must demonstrate an intermediate level of language proficiency (equivalent of 4 semesters of language study) in a foreign language. Students may choose the option best suited to their needs.
- 1 core course (3 units) + 4 elective courses (12 units) = 15 units
