



STUDENT SUCCESS

What We've Done So Far

- Engagement efforts
 - Student Affairs launched early career exploration
 - Established the Office for Undergraduate Research and Inquiry (formerly "QEP")
 - Doubled honors offerings in Boca Raton
- Strategic campaigns
 - Cold-called stopouts who are close to graduation
 - Removed red-tape registration obstacles
 - Restructured advising office to promote a proactive, "contact early and often" model





STUDENT SUCCESS

Where We're Going

- Fall 2013
 - Hired Dr. Jennifer Peluso, Assistant Provost
 - Formed steering team for Task Force
- Spring 2014
 - Task Force charged, led by Assistant Provost
 - Collect data, monitor units, prioritize, plan
- 2014-2015
 - Launch pilot programs, professional development
- 2015-2016
 - Scale up pilots, continuous quality improvement
