PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Recommend BOT approval of amendments to FAU Regulation 1.002, Administrative Organization.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

FAU Regulation 1.002 sets forth the University's administrative organization. The proposed amendments update the regulation to delete outdated governance references and to reflect current organizational titles and add clarity to the scope of delegated responsibilities.

Regulation 1.002 Administrative Organization

—(1) _Tl	he principal officers of the University are:
	(a)The President. The president is the chief executive officer of the niversity and is responsible for the operation and administration of the University. e/she is appointed by the Board of Regents Trustees.
ac	(b)The University Provost <u>and Vice President for Academic Affairs</u> . The niversity Provost shall be responsible to the President for the administration of the cademic affairs of the University and shall perform such other duties as the President any designate.
ac	(c)The Vice President for Administrative Financial Affairs. The Vice resident for Administrative Financial Affairs shall be responsible to the President for the dministration of the University's business affairs and for campus security at the niversity, and shall perform such other duties as the President may designate.
th <u>Ro</u> D er ge	(d)The Vice President for <u>University RelationsCommunity Engagement</u> . The ice President for <u>University RelationsCommunity Engagement</u> shall be responsible to the President for the administration of the <u>Alumni Association</u> , <u>Media and Governmental elations</u> , <u>Advancement Services</u> , <u>Division of University Relations</u> , the <u>Division of evelopment/Alumni Affairs</u> and the Florida Atlantic University Foundation, to incourage advocacy and support of the University by its various constituencies, the eneral public and the media and to perform such other duties as the President may esignate.
	(e)The Vice President for Student Affairs. The Vice President for Student ffairs shall be responsible to the President for the administration of the University's udent affairs and shall perform such other duties as the President may designate.
of	(f)Other Administrative Officers. The President may appoint, subject to the sles and regulations of the Board of RegentsGovernors, such other administrative officers as he/she deems necessary with assignment of duties in the interest of the inversity.

—(2) The academic programs of the University shall be administered by the Colleges. Creation of a new College shall require study and recommendation by the University senate Faculty

<u>Senate</u> and approval by the President, <u>and</u> the Board of <u>Regents Trustees</u>, and, as appropriate, the <u>Board of Governors</u>. The President grants degrees on the recommendation of the faculties of the several Colleges. The Deans of the several Colleges shall administer the academic and budgetary policies of the Colleges and are responsible to the <u>Vice President for Academic Affairs University Provost</u>.

- —(3) Academic units such as the Library and , Division of Learning Resources, Computer Center, Office of the Registrar, Institutes , Division of Sponsored Research, Division of Continuing Education, and similar University agencies shall be administered by the Vice President for Academic Affairs University Provost unless otherwise specified by the President.
- —(4) Organizational Chart. The graphic description of lines of authority on file in the President's office shall be the organization of the University until changed by the President as prescribed by these <u>rules regulations</u>.
