Governance Committee Draft Minutes

Tuesday, January 29, 2019

GC: A-RC. Roll Call

Mr. Abdol Moabery, Chair of the Governance Committee, convened the meeting. Roll call commenced with the following committee members, in addition to Mr. Moabery, participating: Mr. Shaun Davis, Vice Chair; Mr. Anthony Barber (ex-officio), Mr. Brent Burns, Ms. Mary Beth McDonald, Mr. Robert Rubin, Mr. Robert Stilley and Mr. Kevin Wagner.

Chair Moabery noted that this is the committee's first meeting and as such, there are no minutes to approve.

GC: A-1. Request for Approval of Exclusion Resolution for Classified Research

Mr. David Kian, VP of Legal Affairs and General Counsel, presented the item. Mr. Kian stated that FAU is moving into doing classified research for the Department of Defense (DOD) and certain DOD contractors. Undertaking that important work involves having certain key management personnel and each member of a governing board pass a background security clearance and becoming responsible for all of the classified research that is being conducted, or having the board pass a resolution excluding the board from those responsibilities. Passing such a resolution clears the board from the day-to-day oversight and expedites the process for qualifying for these DOD contract task orders and research grants. The proposed resolution, much of whose language is from DOD regulations, accomplishes these ends.

Chair Moabery noted that as a custodian of classified material in his business, he knows it is no simple task. He urged the staff to promptly get the necessary training around it.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the Request for Approval of Exclusion Resolution for Classified Research. With no further discussion or amendments, the motion passed unanimously.

Chair Moabery adjourned the meeting of the Governance Committee.
