SUBJECT: REPORT ON DEGREE PRODUCTIVITY FOR 2010-11

PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

This is an information item. No action required.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A report on FAU's participation in the BOG's Articulation, Coordination and Coherence of Academic Delivery Plan was presented at the April 2011 meeting of the Committee on Academic and Student Affairs. This report looked at degree productivity over a five-year period (2005-2006 through 2009-2010) and our plans for degrees that did not meet threshold criteria. These reports are on the June agendas for the Council of Academic Vice Presidents and the BOG Academic and Student Affairs Committee.

In April 2012, a report on our progress in regard to degree productivity for those programs below the threshold criteria for the 2005-2006 through 2009-2010 summary period will be presented to CASA. Monitoring degree productivity is a continual activity. While data on degrees awarded is still preliminary (the official count of Spring 2011 degrees has not yet been reported to the BOG), a five-year summary for the period 2006-2007 through 2010-2011 does show growth in the number of bachelors and masters degrees awarded. Many of our new degrees are experiencing growth, as expected. Degrees that have been identified for termination are declining in number, also as expected. While it is still early to see the impact of some of the plans to increase the productivity of identified programs, three (050207 Women's Studies, 501003 Music Business, and 500501 Drama and Dramatics) are no longer below threshold.
