SALUTE VETERANS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

- Chartered this spring at FAU to recognize veterans

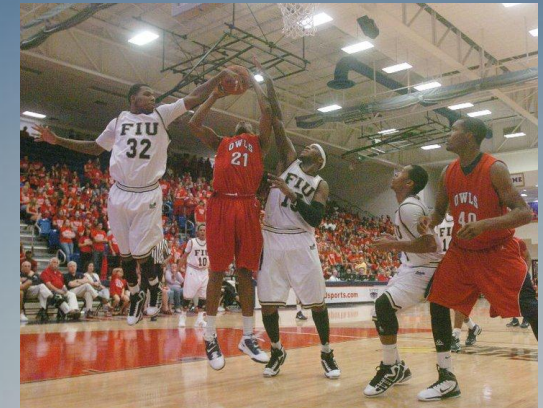
