# FAU/UF Partnership Ad hoc Committee Draft Minutes

June 7, 2022

### UF: A-M. Roll Call

Mr. Brad Levine, Chair of the Board of Trustees FAU/UF Partnership Ad hoc Committee, convened the meeting. ### UF: I-1. Introduction to the Committee and Discussion

Chair Levine opened the committee by noting that the University of Florida (UF) has entered the Jupiter and West Palm Beach market. He asked FAU College of Business Dean Dan Gropper to speak about ways that would be beneficial to FAU partnering with UF.

Dean Gropper said that he and College of Engineering Dean Stella Batalama met as these are the two programs UF is coming into. They discussed research. They would like to propose a collaboration or legislative budget request to staff people in this area to research on analytics, artificial intelligence, computer science, financial services and real estate. If the legislature is going to continue funding these areas, we would like to be partners in that.

Trustee Feingold said when Dean Gropper spoke about research and the state legislature, that's an avenue of collaboration. FAU can put a package together to make a viable presentation to the state. Dean Gropper said they are working on that.

Trustee Cane said UF has a huge super computer that would be great for FAU students to use.
