BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Donation:

Samuel C. Cantor Charitable Trust is making a gift of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) for a recognition opportunity by naming the second floor atrium in the Charles E. Schmidt College of Medicine, BC-71, on the Boca Raton campus, the "Samuel C. Cantor Charitable Trust By Eddy and Helaine Cantor Second Floor Atrium".

Gift Purpose:

The donation will be used to create the Samuel C. Cantor Charitable Trust Research Fund and will provide support for cancer research in the Charles E. Schmidt College of Medicine.
