Academic Service-Learning Course Guidelines

In order for your course to be designated as an Academic Service-Learning (AS-L) course at Florida Atlantic University, the AS-L project within your syllabus must contain/demonstrate the following criteria:

- 1. Academic Service-Learning Statement (See below.)*
- 2. **Relevant and Meaningful Service in the Community** The AS-L project should be applicable to the course and worthwhile in meeting community needs.
- 3. Enhanced Academic Learning The AS-L project should complement what is learned in the classroom and provide an experience in a "real world" setting.
- 4. **Purposeful Civic Engagement** The AS-L project should be designed to have students practice the learning strategies and/or content of the class that meets course learning objectives in a community setting.
- 5. **Critical Reflection** The AS-L project should ask students to reflect on how the project links to (1) course objectives, (2) the impact of the students' work in the community, and (3) the impact on the students' personal and professional development.*
- 6. Hours Required FAU requires students spend a minimum of 10 hours on the AS-L project.*
- 7. Assessment Syllabus should state how AS-L project will be assessed.*
- 8. Assumption of Risk Statement* (See below)
