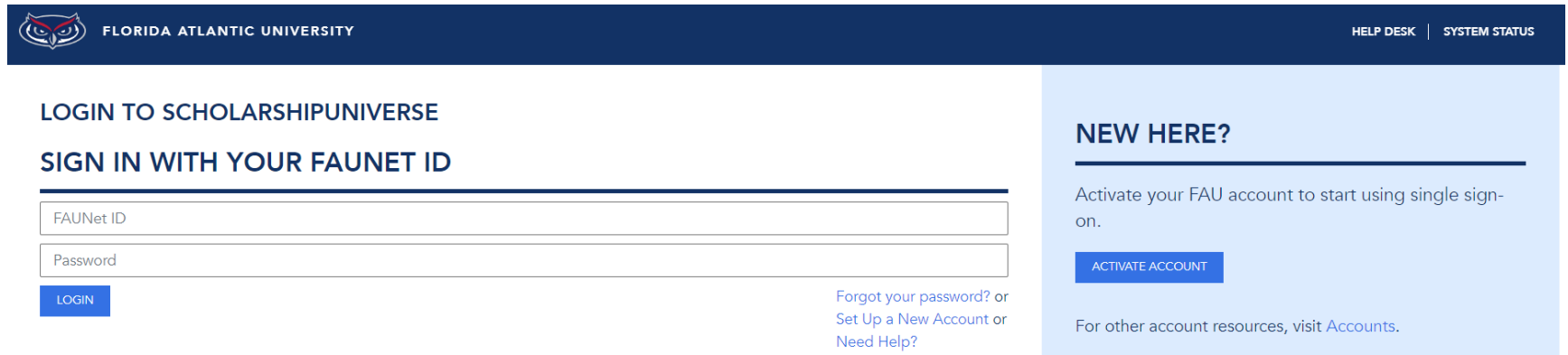


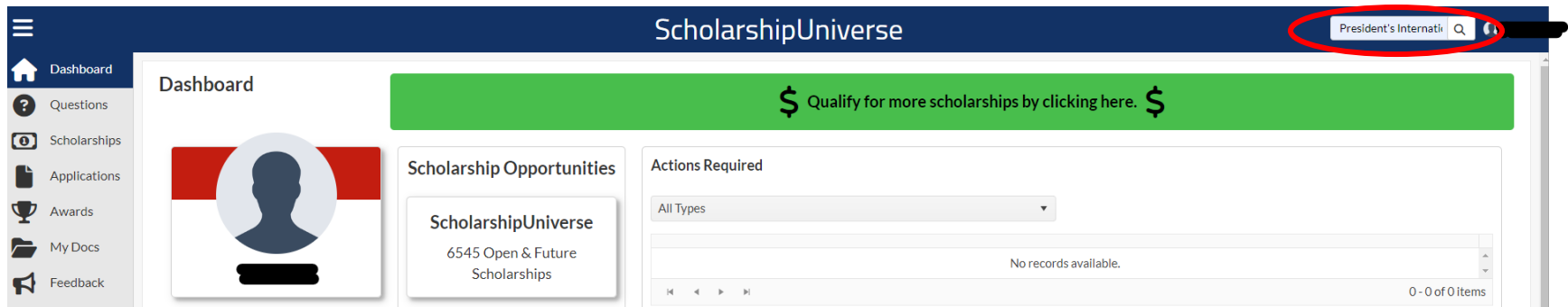
FAU President's International Scholarship Application Guide

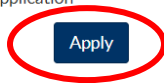
