- **Conduct:** A "yes" answer to either of the conduct questions on the online application will \checkmark require a written explanation. Additional information may be requested when your application is under review. Applications will not be fully processed until all conduct issues are cleared.
- Application status: Once your application has been submitted, you can check your \checkmark application status online to ensure transcripts and test scores have been received.
- Residency classification: Your residency classification automatically defaults to non-Florida. \checkmark After you are admitted, the residency officer will request additional documents by email if needed.
