SUBJECT: Update to Corequisites for ACG 3131 (Intermediate Theory 1).

The School of Accounting wishes to add a prerequisite or corequisite for ACG 3131 (Intermediate Theory 1) by requiring that FIN 3403 (Principles of Financial Management) be taken before or concurrently with ACG3131. The proposed update is designed to ensure that students have some preliminary knowledge and understanding of issues, such as the time value of money, that have applications to accounting topics discussed in ACG3131, such as bonds and receivables. The addition of FIN 3403 as a corequisite is consistent with the accounting undergraduate flight plan (http://www.fau.edu/uas/curriculum.php), which recommends that FIN 3403 be taken during the semester in which ACG 3131 is taken. Thus, the addition of FIN 3403 will not increase the amount of time a student takes to complete his or her undergraduate degree.
