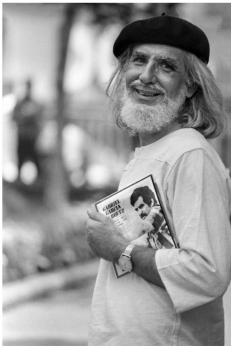
Ana Cristina Henríquez
