# Audit & Compliance Committee Draft Minutes

April 16, 2024

### AC: A-M. Roll Call and Approval of the February 8, 2024 Meeting Minutes

Trustee Flippo asked for approval of the February 8, 2024 meeting minutes. A motion was made and seconded to approve the February 8, 2024 Audit and Compliance meeting minutes. With no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

## AC: I-1. Review of FAU Athletics Department Independent Accountant's Report for FY 2022-2023 Agreed-Upon Procedures

Mr. Brian White, VP Athletics, presented the item. Mr. White asked Ken Ziel from James Moore, CPA to present any findings. Mr. Ziel noted that the procedures are outlined by the NCAA. This reporting is a little different than general accounting principles as the NCAA has their own format. This is not an audit of financial statements. It is a prescribed reporting that is required to be submitted by FAU to the NCAA annually. They did not have any findings as part of the agreed-upon procedures.
