Recommend that the BoT approves naming the Bioimaging Lab in the Marcus Research and Innovation Center in the AD Henderson University School/FAU High School Complex (the "ADHUS/FAU High School Complex"). The proposed name of the Bioimaging Lab will be the "Berlin Family Bioimaging Lab".

BACKGROUND INFORMATON

Donation:

On January 24, 2022, Joshua M. Berlin signed a Gift Agreement donating \$100,000 for a recognition opportunity to be identified at a later date. Dr. Berlin and the FAU Foundation have recently updated the Gift Agreement to provide for naming the Bioimaging Lab in the Marcus Research and Innovation Center in the AD Henderson University School/FAU High School Complex the "Berlin Family Bioimaging Lab".

Gift Purpose:

The gift was given to support the planning, financing, constructing, and equipping the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex.

Donor's Background:

Joshua M. Berlin, M.D. serves as the president, secretary, and director for Joshua Berlin, P.A. Mr. Berlin serves as member of the Board of Advisors for University of Pennsylvania, School of Nursing, and previously, he served on the advisory board for the Graduate School of Education. Joshua Berlin completed his residency in dermatology at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation in Cleveland, Ohio, earned an M.D. from Pennsylvania State University in 1999, and an undergraduate degree from University of Pennsylvania, Wharton School of Business in 1995.
