#### Academic Libraries Overview

Reason	There is a decrease in the number of books (title count), physical, from the previous year due to having access to more accurate data this past year, which was available in a new report that FLVC has created in Alma Analytics that reports unique title counts.			
Upload File	The number entered (9,592) is outside the expected range of between 12,944 and 24,038 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15015)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason	The reason for the decrease in total circulation, physical, from last year is due to a decrease in book borrowing, fewer visitors to the building after the pandemic, and the fact that the Libraries have prioritized the expansion of electronic titles, which means the newest and most popular books are electronic, and not physical items for our borrowers to check out.			
Upload File	The number entered (761,999) is outside the expected range of between 72,565 and 134,761 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15015)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason	The large increase is due to the IPEDS survey number for Total Digital/Electronic Circulation (ACRL question 61C) for FY 2021-2022 being reported incorrectly. It should have been reported as 1,039,503 (103,663 (e-books and e-media usage) + 935,840 (e-serials usage).			
Upload File	The number entered (4,643) is outside the expected range of between 28,140 and 52,258 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15015)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason	There is a decrease in the number of serials, physical, from the previous year due to having access to more accurate data this past year, which was available in a new report that FLVC has created in Alma Analytics that reports unique title counts.			
Upload File	The All Other Paid Staff(4.13) is outside the expected range compared to All Other Paid Staff reported in the prior year(1.02). Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15814)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason	The reason for the increase in the number of all other paid staff is due to library staffing being lower in previous years, so there was a need to increase staffing.			
Upload File	The Student Assistants(7.50) is outside the expected range compared to Student Assistants reported in the prior year(2.46). Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15815)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason	The reason for the increase in the number of student assistants is due to library staffing being lower in previous years, so there was a need to increase staffing.
