



Title: Project Review Board (PRB)

Purpose:

The purpose of the project review board (PRB) is to ensure technology projects submitted to the Office of Information Technology (OIT) are evaluated prior to being approved or denied by governance. The board is responsible to ensure that projects:

- a. Are Feasible.
- b. There is no duplication with other technologies.
- c. Meets compliance standards.
- d. Are properly staffed with correct OIT resources.
- e. Are properly aligned based on capacity.
- f. Technological complexities are reviewed.
- g. Are not a cyber security risk.

The PRB is not the governing body for technology projects. Its mission is to ensure projects are properly staffed, feasible and to discuss any technology opportunities and/or challenges each project might present if approved.

Meetings:

The PRB will meet once a month to review project submissions. Meeting length will vary based on the number projects available for review.
